PART A: HORTICULTURAL DIVISION

Please identify cultivar(s), where possible

Section A: Roses

- Class 1. Hybrid Tea – one stem, any colour
- Class 2. Floribunda – one stem or bloom, any colour
- Class 3. Climber – one spray, any colour
- Class 4. Grandiflora – one stem or bloom, any colour
- Class 5. A.O.C. (any other cultivar) - one bloom or spray
- Class 6. Bi - colour – one bloom or spray
- Class 7. Floating Rose - must float free of bowl, no foliage

Section B: Iris – one stem of each

- Class 8. Bearded self - one solid colour
- Class 9. Bearded Bi - colour or Bi- tone - standards and falls different colours
- Class 10. Beardless – Siberian
- Class 11. Beardless - Japanese
- Class 12. A.O.C. (any other cultivar)

Section C: Peonies - each class one bloom, any colour, no side buds

- Class 13. Single cultivar
- Class 14. Any double or semi-double
- Class 15. Tree
- Class 16. Itoh

Section D: Other flower classes

- Class 17. Allium, Short cultivar under 61 cm 24 inches - three stems
- Class 18. Allium, Tall cultivar taller than 63.5 cm 25 inches – one stem
- Class 19. Aquilegia (Columbine) - one stem
- Class 20. Heuchera/Tiarella/Heucherella – one cultivar 3 leaves
- Class 21. Heuchera /Tiarella /Heucherella - five cultivars, one leaf each
- Class 22. Hosta, miniature leaf - three cultivars, one leaf each
less than 39 sq. cm. (less than 6 sq. inches)
- Class 23. Hosta, medium leaf - three cultivars, one leaf each
193 to less than 413 sq. cm. (30 to less than 64 sq. inches)
- Class 24. Hosta, large leaf - three cultivars, one leaf each
413 to less than 774 sq. cm. (64 sq. to less than 120 sq. inches)
- Class 25. Flowering shrub - one branch, no more than 61cm. (24 inches)
- Class 26. Any perennial not listed above - one bloom or stem
- Class 27. Collection of cut flowers – five cultivars, maximum 12 stems

Section E: Potted Houseplants

- Class 28. African violet, any variety
- Class 29. Cactus, single plant
- Class 30. Succulent, single plant
- Class 31. Any flowering plant, not listed

Section F: Vegetables

- Class 32. One vegetable - three specimens, plate provided
leaf specimens may be displayed in vase
- Class 33. Collection of vegetables - three cultivars, one specimen of each
- Class 34. Collection of cut herbs in individual containers with water, three-five stems
identified

PART B: DESIGN DIVISION – Design maximum width 61 cm 24 inches except
Miniature class

- Class 1. Sailing Away – Armature design incorporating triangle(s)
- Class 2. Three of a Kind – Parallel Vegetative design
- Class 3. Drop in a Bucket – Miniature design - maximum 12.7 cm, 5 in. in height,
width and depth.
- Class 4. Free as a Bird - Free Style
- Class 5. Ying Yang – 2 opposing subjects on one base
